




Uncoated N-BK7 Typical Transmission

Typical transmission of a 3mm thick N-BK7 window with MgF_2 (400-700nm) coating at 0° AOI.



Typical transmission of a 3mm thick N-BK7 window with MS-EXT (350-700nm) coating at 0° AOI.










